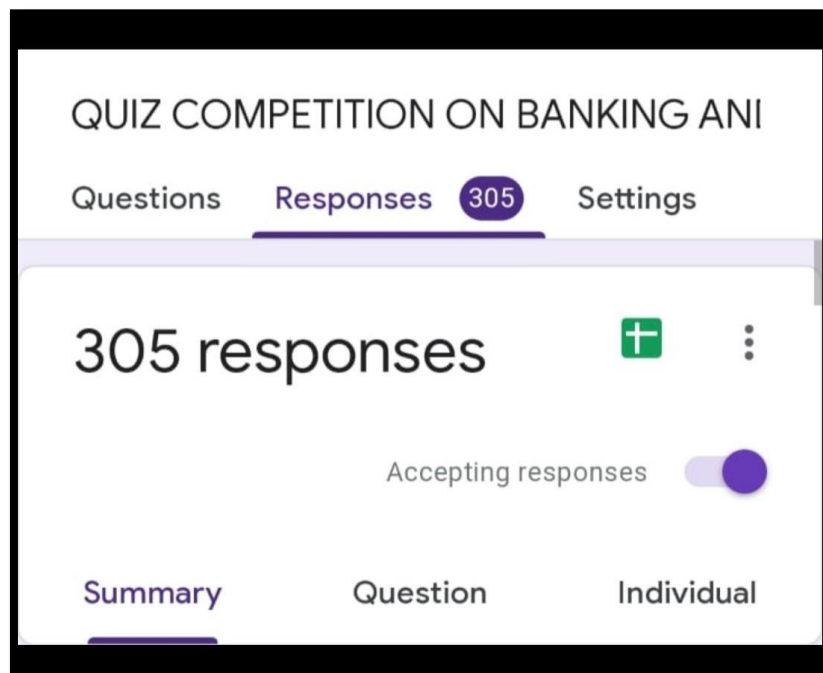

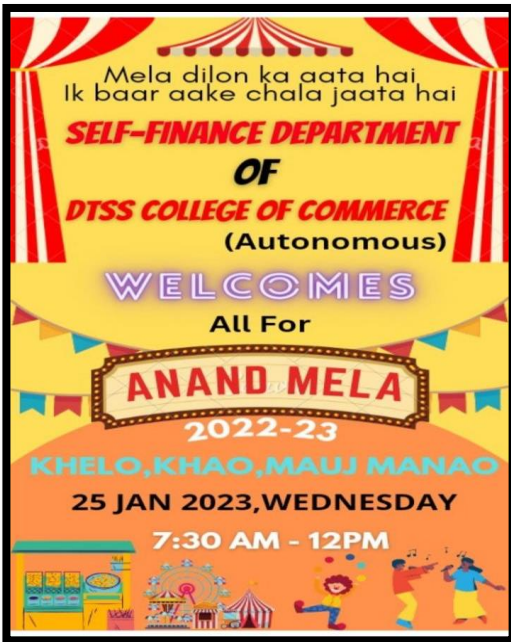
#### **Report:**

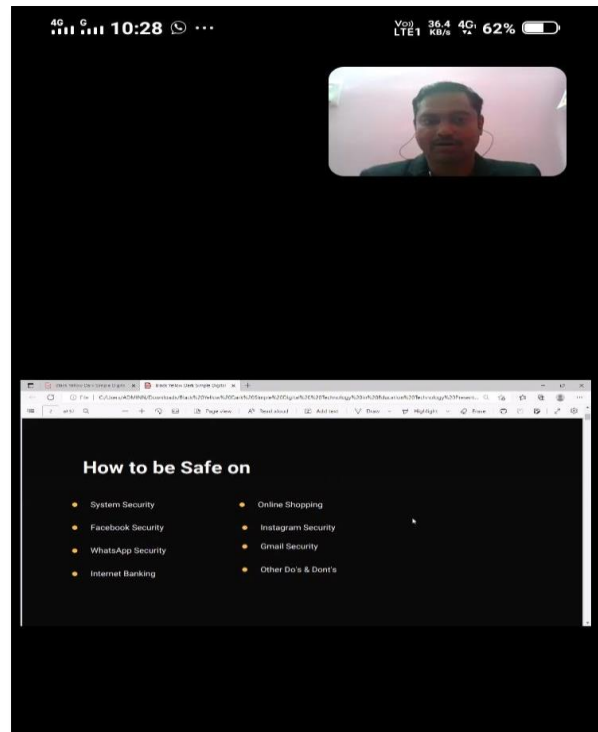

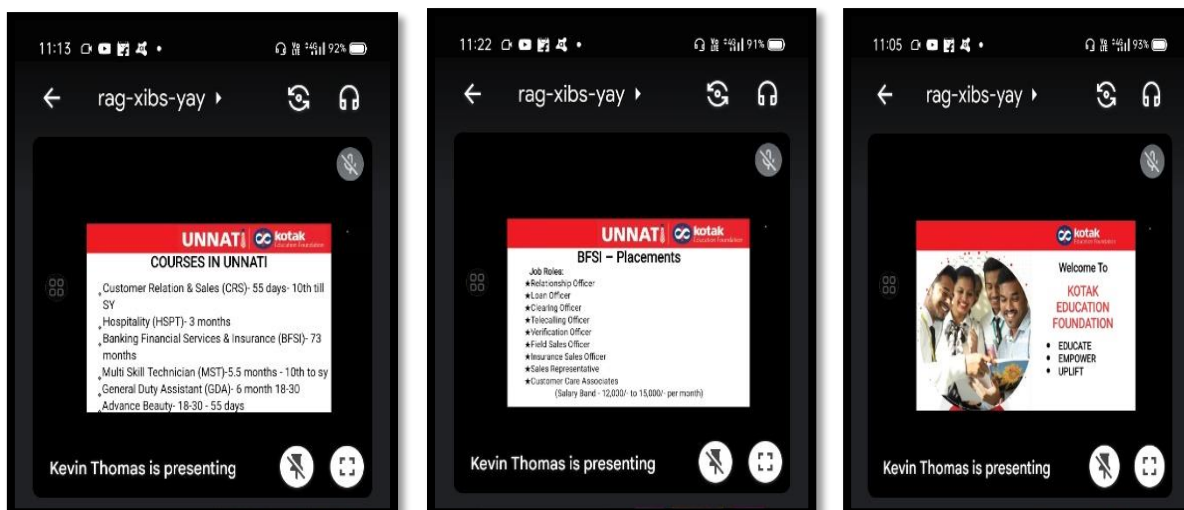
